

Project Evaluation

1. Project evaluation system

- a) The evaluation uses evaluation criteria that will be published at www.jihovychod.cz;
- b) The assessment of the technical portion of a project over CZK 10 million of total costs shall be performed by an expert evaluator; projects over CZK 50 million of total costs by two expert evaluators;
- c) Evaluations use scores with a 100-point maximum.

2. What is evaluated

- a) The applicant's financial solvency and experience;
- b) The project's quality and feasibility;
- c) The project's necessity and sustainability;
- d) Management;
- e) Horizontal criteria (sustainable development, equal opportunities, information society development).

3. Project approval

- a) Before publishing a call for applications, the Board of the Regional Council approves a minimum score a project has to reach to be approved;
- b) The Board of the Regional Council approves the amount of financial resources distributed in a call;
- c) The employees of the Office of the Regional Council consult, collect and evaluate the projects in cooperation with expert evaluators;
- d) Expert evaluators are selected based on their experience in a given field (transport construction, building construction, financial analyses, etc.) All expert evaluators attend evaluation training at the Office of the Regional Council before a call for applications is published.
- e) At least two employees from the Office of the Regional Council perform the evaluation (the so-called four eyes principle);
- f) The Office of the Regional Council submits a list of evaluated projects arranged by scores to the Board of the Regional Council for approval.
- g) The Board of the Regional Council approves the best projects up to the published amount of allocation.
